The Roger Williams Memorial Scholarship

The Manatee County Historical Society sponsors a \$1,000 college scholarship for a student graduating from a Manatee County high school and having an interest in history. A degree in history leads to jobs in writing, teaching, archives, museums, law, diplomacy, cultural affairs, business, and international commerce.

Eligible students must plan to major in history or a related field at the college level as well as have shown an interest in history through volunteering, tutoring, History Day Fair participation, or other related activity.

The student must attach a transcript of grades from their high school and a personal essay (750 word maximum) on their interest in history, academic and career plans, and a short statement of financial need by **March 1**st. Selected award recipients will be contacted via email by **April 15**th. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the student's future college or university.
